

Whether you're new to the wheel or deepening a passion for ceramics, our studio offers a peaceful, creative space inspired by the natural beauty of the mountains.

Ranch Hand Pottery



Perfect for beginners or those returning to clay, your private session begins with a live demonstration on how to create a bowl, vase, or mug. Guests will receive two one-pound pieces of clay, one-on-one instruction, and learn foundational techniques including centering and throwing. Each guest will complete one to two unique pieces, which the artist will glaze and fire for a beautiful keepsake from the ranch.

** FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ***

Do I need a reservation?

Reservations are highly encouraged for all adventures and arts experiences, but not required.

Do I tip my wranglers/guides/studio teachers?

A 20% service charge is included in all noted rates. Tax will be added to each booking.

What is your cancellation policy?

If a cancellation is made due to weather, or before 7 p.m. the night prior there is no cancellation fee. If a cancellation is received after 7 p.m. the night prior to a scheduled activity, the cancellation fee is 100% of the adventure booked. If a different activity is rebooked at the same time, there is no change or cancellation fee.

Can I book a private arts experience for my family or group?

Yes! Any group workshop can be booked as a private experience for a minimal additional fee.

What should I wear for Horseback Riding?

We recommended wearing long pants and closed toe shoes are required. We can provide saddle bags to store anything you'd like to bring on the ride, or you are welcome to bring your own backpack.
